The ship was generally examined ^{AFLOAT} in July 1933.

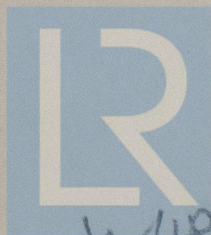
The case received further consideration in May 1934 (Special Survey 3 years overdue) when no general examination was required.

In reply to enquiry the Rotterdam Surveyors write that the vessel is still laid up.

Another Special Survey became due 4,35.

It is submitted for consideration whether the Owners should be asked to arrange for the ship to be again generally examined.
