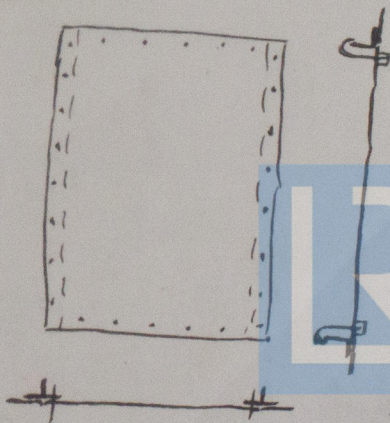
I have sent

bolt pass through the bulkhead
the plates. Along the top & bottom,
the bolts are of the hooked

pattern and pass thro' the plate
only, the hook making the attachment
to the bulkhead. I should be
glad to know if I am right
in reporting the case as I have
done seeing the side bolts form
the principal fastening & are
correct to rule.

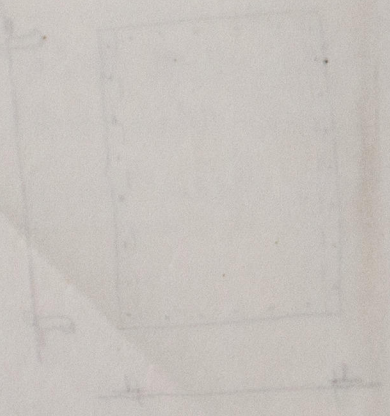
