With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "METHILHILL", which is now lying near Lisbon after having sustained considerable damage through fire on the 3rd instant. I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a report received from this Society's Surveyor at Lisbon, from which it appears that the vessel is a Constructive Total Loss, and I am directed to inform you that, in all the circumstances, the Committee have decided to make a record of "Burnt 8,35" against the vessel's name in the Register Book, and at the same time to expunge her class in accordance with the usual practice.
