I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Barry report that the steamer "CHARLEBURY" has been examined afloat, a satisfactory General Examination carried out, including the windlass, steering gear and pumps and an interim certificate has been issued enabling the vessel to proceed to Alexandria with a cargo of coal, thence via a Mediterranean port to Japan where she will be broken up. 
