The 2nd Special Survey N° 2 which became due in April, 1934, has been partly held.

The vessel was sold to Japanese purchasers for breaking up purposes, & proceeded to Osaka after general examination by the Hull Surveyors.

The Kobe Surveyors stated, in a communication dated 23rd April, that she had arrived at the breaking up yards at Osaka, but the work of demolition has not yet commenced.
