The necessary requirements are now being carried out and will be completed and the freeboards verified tomorrow.

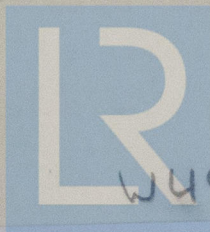
