


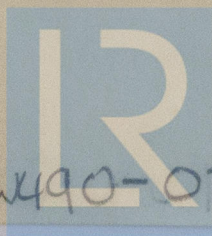
The 2nd S.S.No.3 became due 1,35 and a proposal to carry out same within the year of grace has been agreed to in view of a general examination made in August last.

The London Surveyors report that at the request of the Owners and with a view to the issue of an interim certificate a satisfactory general examination has been made of the vessel afloat including the examination of the windlass and steering gear and found satisfactory.

The vessel is proceeding to the River Clyde where it is stated she will be broken up.

It is submitted action be deferred and the Glasgow Surveyors requested to advise this Office when the work of demolition has commenced.
