John Chambers Ltd's No.512, I shall be glad if he will be good enough to state if the frames in way of the raised quarter deck are ordinary or bulb angles, whether the raised quarter deck stringer plate is .50" abreast the openings as approved, the size of the forecastle deck stringer angle, and whether the rivets in the edges of the sheerstrake and keel are  $\frac{7}{8}$ " diameter as approved or  $\frac{3}{4}$ " diameter as given in his report.

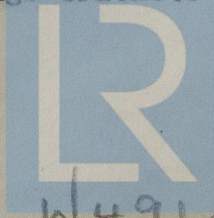
