Dear Martell,

With reference to the Newcastle first entry report No.73326 on the Engines No.606 built by Messrs. G. T. Gray & Co., Ltd., for a vessel building by Messrs. Chambers of Lowestoft, I take it that you have applied for the fee which you have entered on the report, viz:- first entry fee £2; special survey fee £5:1:0. The doubt has been raised in view of a pencilled note which also appears against the fee, viz:- "To be applied for from London".

I conclude that the only fee that we shall have to apply for is the proportion due for the installation on board, and that this will be chargeable to the firm who carry out the work.

Kindly let me have a line in reply so that I may know exactly how the case stands.
