
Dear Sir,

Further to my reply yesterday to your memorandum of the 24th instant regarding the case of the steam trawler "ADMIRAL CRADOCK", I beg to advise you that I have now been able to discuss the case with a Representative of the Owner, who mentioned that Captain Walsh the Owner is in financial difficulties and wished to make another fishing trip with the vessel before dealing with the repairs.

I examined the bunker bulkhead and machinery casing top as the vessel was discharging and am of opinion that these are efficient for another voyage.

Notice of the Screwshaft Survey due at the end of July last was also given.

In my opinion it is doubtful if the Owner will be able to deal with the repairs to this vessel on her return and it is submitted that a letter^{be} addressed to Messrs. Endeavor Trawlers Ltd. advising them that the vessel's class will be dealt with if she is not stopped for repair




