S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant regarding your steamer "AUNGBAN" and am much obliged to you for the confirmation of Mr. Reed's interview with you on the 22nd instant.

The matter has been very carefully considered and in all the circumstances it is proposed to reinsert the vessel under Japanese Ownership as the "TOEN MARU" ex "AUNGBAN" (as a disclassified ship) in the forthcoming edition of the Society's Register Book.
