With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No. 2 which became due at the end of May last on the steamer "AUNGBAN", I have to acquaint you that following a satisfactory General Examination carried out at Calcutta in May the Committee agreed to a proposal of the Owners to run this vessel until their new Tanker was delivered when she would proceed to Japan to be broken up.

It is observed from the Shipping Papers the vessel left Melbourne on the 13th instant for Osaka, and I shall therefore be glad if you will keep this case in mind and advise me as soon as the work of demolition is commenced.
