The second Special Survey No. 2 became due in July 1932, and the Boiler Survey in April 1933.

The vessel was generally examined at Newcastle in October 1932, and a proposal to complete the Special Survey within the year of grace was agreed to in October last.

In August last the Owners proposed to defer holding the Survey for some months, but they were informed on the 9th ultimo that the Committee were agreeable to the inspection being postponed for a further period, but they must ask them to make arrangements for the Special Survey ^{Sept} to be held during this month.

The Owners now state that the vessel has been laid up over a month passing her Boiler Survey, and they have spent approximately £200 in this connexion and have ^{made} a very first class job of it.

They state they do not wish unduly to trespass on the courtesy of the Committee, but they do hope that this may be brought before them so that they may grant at any rate a further extension of two months.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
