With reference to the London letter of the 9th instant respecting the steamer "ELSIE ANNIE" I beg to state that I have ascertained that the following work was examined in Cammell Laird & Co's yard on the 6th July 1933:-

1. All wood side fore and afters in cargo hatchway have been renewed to Convention requirements and are steel shod.
3. The hatch covers are in good condition.
5. The freeing port area in the Raised Quarter Deck has been raised to 14.37 square feet, viz:-

3 @ 2'6" x 1'3"	-	9.37 sq. ft.
2 @ 2'6" x 1'0"	-	5.00 sq. ft.
6. The closing appliances on the Machinery casing and forecastle doors are in good condition.
