3. The hatch covers are in good condition.
5. The freeing port area in the Raised Quarter Deck has been raised to 14.37 square feet, vix:-
 

3 @ 2'6" x 1'3"	-	9.37 sq. ft.
2 @ 2'6" x 1'0"	-	5.00 sq. ft.
6. The closing appliances on the Machinery casing and forecastle doors are in good condition.
