Nature of Survey

1st entry.

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the report should be returned to the Surveyors and they should be requested to state thereon whether the deck is of iron or steel as on the first page they state it is iron and on the 3rd page steel. They should be requested to fill in the particulars of the kedge anchor if the same has been supplied to the vessel, and should also fill in whether the vessel has been built under special survey, their opinion as to the class and whether freeboard is a condition of the class. (The midship section should be returned to them.)
