Following our conversation today when you stated your intention of cabling your Owners, I forwarded the following cable to our London office in code.

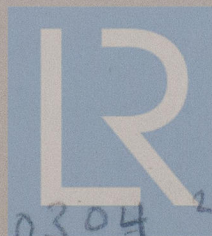
