Survey

The Kobe Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock and the requirements of the 1st S.S.No.2, due 3,36, partly complied with.

The bottom has been cleaned and coated, one pintle renewed, repairs effected to steering gear and leads, ^{centre line bulkhead} tank ~~sub~~ brackets and minor repairs carried out.

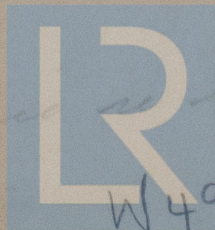
Owing to damage by grounding and jettisoning deck cargo etc., overload on derricks and ice, 12 shell plates have been renewed and repairs and renewals effected to shell plating, frames, reverse frames, floors, tank side brackets, tank margin, bilge keel, rudder, piping, bulwarks, rails, mainmast, rigging, deck fittings and minor repairs carried out.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 8,35.
