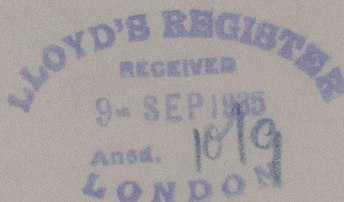

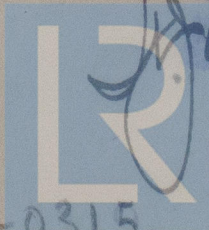
I received a cablegram from you to-day reading as
