on the 20th July, 1935 and subsequently, whilst the vessel lay in dry dock at Mitsubishi for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of damage stated to have been caused by (A) Grounding on Minirara Island, P.I. on the 30th June, 1935, whilst on a voyage from Borneo to Osaka, (B) by Jettisoning deck cargo and by using the vessel's machinery and equipment while endeavouring to refloat her between the 30th June and 4th July, 1935.

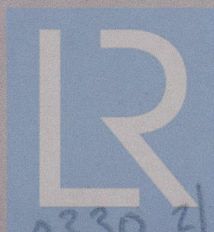
