

TRANSLATION OF LETTER RECEIVED AT LLOYD'S REGISTER, BILBAO,
FROM
AUXILIAR MARITIMA, S. A., BILBAO, DATED 9/12/32.

Dear Sirs,

As the International Security Conventions of human life at sea and Loadline will shortly be coming into force, we shall be glad if you will enquire from your London Office, whether the operations required by the application of the prescriptions of the aforementioned Conventions may be carried out whilst the vessel afloat, as we find that in the case of the s.s. "GUERNICA", in spite of our good wishes of desiring to bring the vessel to Bilbao, within the present year, it is not possible for us to do so until the end of February next;

Therefore, in order to avoid any calamity abroad, we beg you to kindly communicate with your London Office as soon as possible, and ascertain at the same time whether we can delay the compliance of these prescriptions until the vessel comes to Bilbao, which as already stated above, will be towards the end of February next.
