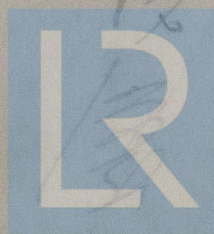
I shall therefore feel obliged to you if you will add $\frac{1}{2}$ behind the 9 on my report ,
