

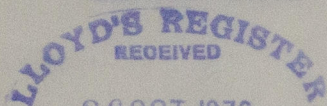

Sir,

Referring to our letter of the 24th instant, we herewith enclose old freeboard certificates (in duplicate) for the steamer "AUSTRALIA" for cancellation, and have to state that all the requirements as indicated in the assignment letter of the 20th instant have now been carried out, as follows:-

- (1) Efficient means for closing all air pipes have now been provided by fitting wood plugs, and canvas covers where necessary. Ventilator coamings to accommodation in poop space fitted with wood plugs and canvas covers.
- (2) Gangway on port side of fore well examined and found efficient.
- (3) Storm boards now fitted in riveted channels for full height in openings in fore-castle bulkhead.
- (5) Sanitary discharges from intact space in long poop are provided with storm valves.

The new Convention Freeboard Certificates have now been issued.
