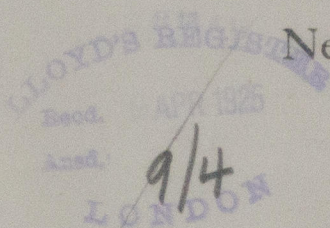


# Lloyd's Register of Shipping,

We understand from Brokers, that vessel is now at Swansea and leaves there on the 11th instant for Manchester and Liverpool. Freeboard assignment has been forwarded to Swansea Surveyors with request to have same marked, verified and reported to London Office (see copy of letter attached), as in our opinion vessel is eligible to Freeboard Certificate for a period of 12 months issued on form for unclassed vessels.
