Dear Sirs,

With reference to your freeboard report No. 21312 on the S.S. "AUSTRALIA", I have to acquaint you that it is understood this vessel has now returned to your port.

If it is not possible to complete the reclassification survey at this time, I shall be glad if you will state whether, in your opinion, a freeboard certificate for a limited period of say six months might be issued on the form for Unclassed vessels, pending the completion of the survey. If so, you should verify the freeboards and forward the usual verification marking form, in order that the certificates may be issued.

It is understood that the Owners have returned the previous certificate issued by the Board of Trade to them for cancellation.
