Précis of particulars of Casualty This vessel, when she was the "GOTHIC", sustained extensive damage by aircraft at Barcelona in October last, and in all the circumstances, the Committee decided to expunge her class and make the record "Damaged by aircraft 10,38 - Now in port" against her name in the Register Book.

According to Lloyd's Shipping Index the vessel has resumed trading.

In accordance with the standing instructions, the case is again submitted to the Committee in order that the standing record may be altered to "Damaged by aircraft 10,38 - Now trading".
