


The 3rd S.S.No.2 became due 7,35, and the vessel has been laid up at Appledore under the undertaking.

On 31st ultimo the Plymouth Surveyor stated that the vessel would be proceeding to Newport to be broken up, and he was informed that he could issue a certificate for the voyage provided he was satisfied with the vessel's condition. He was also instructed to advise this Office should the vessel leave without being submitted to his inspection.

The Surveyor now writes stating that the vessel arrived in Llanelly last week to be broken up.

It is submitted a record of "To be broken up" be posted against this vessel's name in the Register Book, and the class be cancelled.
