I duly received your letter of yesterday's date from which it is noted that negotiations are now in hand for the sale of the steamer "ABERCRAIG" to an Estonian Firm.

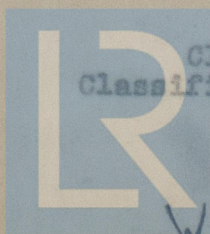
It is further noted that the purchasers are considering the idea of moving her to a home (Estonian) port with cargo.

Such an arrangement, however, would of course require the Committee's sanction, having regard to the undertaking under which her class has hitherto been allowed to remain undisturbed, and, in the event of your being approached on this point you should at once forward full particulars of the nature of the voyage and cargo proposed to this Office, together with any relevant information.

You should at the same time arrange for the vessel's movements to be carefully watched, so that immediate advice may be sent to this Office in the event of her being moved without complying with the terms of the undertaking.
