I note that you have decided to send this steamer to Appledore, Devon, to be laid up and may say that in the circumstances the Committee will raise no objection to this procedure.

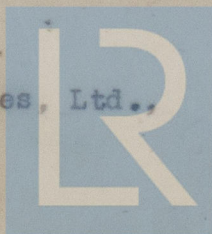
It is of course concluded that the vessel will be proceeding to Appledore in ballast trim.
