Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th instant confirming the interview with your representative respecting the steamer "ABERCRAIG" which vessel is now your property.

As was pointed out to you yesterday the Third Special Survey No. 2 became due on this vessel so long ago as July, 1935, and in accordance with an arrangement made with the late Owners this survey should have been completed not later than the end of last month.

As there seems to have been some little misunderstanding with the late Owners, the Committee have had your letter before them at their meeting today and have agreed to allow the vessel's class to remain undisturbed in the Register Book provided you will furnish the necessary undertaking to carry out the requirements of this survey before the vessel again goes into commission.

It is understood that the vessel is now at St. Ives Bay awaiting an opportunity to proceed to Hayle and that failing a laying up berth at Hayle being available you propose to take her to Falmouth for this purpose.
