The 3rd S.S.No.2 became due 7,35 and after an examination took place in January last a proposal to carry out same within the year of grace was agreed to.

No.2 keel plate (from aft) and some shell riveting require attention at the Special Survey.

The case received the consideration of the Committee on the instant when the Owners, being undecided whether to carry out the Special Survey, were informed that unless the Survey was carried out within the year of grace the vessel's class would require to be dealt with at the Special Survey.

A report has now been received from the Falmouth Surveyors to the effect that the Special Survey was partly held afloat last year and some repairs and renewals recommended.

A further letter having been received from the Owners that they expected to complete the sale of the steamer to purchasers who would put the vessel through survey immediately they were notified that the Committee considered this should have been done within the year of grace (which expired 7,36), and that unless arrangements are made at once to deal with the Survey the Committee have no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's name to be expunged with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

The attached telegram has now been received from the Chief Ship Surveyor to the effect that the vessel sailed on the 24th
