The Stream anchor is 1 cwt 1 qtr lies in weight than required by Table 22, but the kedge anchor is 3 qrs 14 lbs in excess of the weight required by Table 22. The Surveyor states that these anchors had been accepted by the Germanischer Lloyd, and it is hoped the stream anchor will be approved by the Committee, and they add that they were not aware of the deficiency in weight until it was too late to submit the same for the consideration of the Committee.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed *+ 100A-1 ("Stat") as recommended.*
