It is submitted that before this case reaches the consideration of the Committee, the Hamburg Surveyors should be requested to state whether they recommend the vessel as eligible for the Fig. 1 for equipment ~~in the class~~, in view of their having omitted this in their recommendation regarding the class of the vessel, and of the stream anchor being $\frac{1}{4}$ cwt less in weight than required by Table 22. They should also be requested to state whether they drew the Builders' attention to the deficiency in the weight of the stream anchor.
