s.s. "MUNOBREANS", N.Yk.Rpt.No. 26681. The question of additional support for the through beams of the second deck of this vessel was taken up with the Owners, but nothing was done at the time as they informed us this deck would be used to carry passengers only.

The necessary inquiries are being made in the remaining cases.
