Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 23rd instant respecting the steamer "SONNENFELS", and with regard thereto I may say that this vessel was classed 100A- in August last, no particulars of the anchors and chain cables being then available. A report, however, has recently been received from the Society's Surveyors at Newport, Mon., of an examination of the anchors, particulars of the markings on the same being furnished by the Surveyors. They state, however, that no certificates for the anchors are available, but that the latter have been tested at approved machines in this country, and that the weights are as required by Table 31 of the Rules except that the stream anchor is slightly light. The collective weight of the anchors is in excess of the requirements.


In the circumstances the Figure 1 has now been assigned, and I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners' Representatives accordingly.
