The cable certificates were issued in Germany during the war, and under the circumstances there is a question as to their validity. The Owners would like new certificates issued, if this is necessary.


The German cable certificates are enclosed herewith, and we also enclose the Classification Certificate of the vessel for amendment if the Figure 1 is assigned by the Committee.
