

This form of Certificate is applicable solely to Chain Cables manufactured out of the United Kingdom, and supplied to Foreign Owned Vessels which are classed or intended for classification in Lloyd's Register of British and Foreign Shipping.

Should the Chain described herein be lost or destroyed, this Certificate is to be returned to the Secretary of Lloyd's Register, London, for the purpose of being cancelled. If the Chain be impaired or otherwise altered, so as to destroy its identity with the Certificate, the facts are to be reported to the Secretary, or one of the Society's Surveyors, in order that the Certificate may be altered accordingly.
