With reference to the case of the ex-German Steamer "SONNENWELLS", which is now being re-surveyed for an additional six months for the Ministry of Shipping at your port, I enclose herewith Bremen First Entry Report No. 430 on this vessel, from which you will observe that this Steamer was built in Germany in 1914-15 under the inspection of the Society's Surveyors.

From the attached correspondence, it will also be seen that the present Managers for the Ministry are desirous of having the Steamer classed with this Society, and I have therefore to request that you will give this case the necessary attention with a view to the Special Survey No. 1 being completed, if the requirements of the same have not already been complied with, and a report on Forms 8 & 9 should be forwarded in the usual way.

I should add that the Managers' Superintendent in this city states that he understands the vessel has been thoroughly examined at this time, and that very little additional work will be required to comply with the requirements of the Special Survey No. 1, but I shall be glad if you will be good
