He hereby engage to pay the established Special Survey Fees as per Sec. 29 of the Rules, as follows, viz.
 For ships built under the special superintendence of the Surveyors (to entitle them to the distinctive mark ✕),
 1s. per ton for the first 1,000 tons, and 6d. per ton for every ton beyond 1,000 tons. No fee, however, shall
 be less than £7 0s. 0d.

For engines and new boilers built under the special superintendence of the Surveyors (to entitle them to the distinctive mark ✕ in red).
 For engines and boilers up to 200 Nominal Horse Power, three shillings per Horse Power. For engines and boilers over 200
 Nominal Horse Power, three shillings per Horse Power for the first 200 Horse Power, and one shilling per Horse Power
 above 200. No fee to be less than £8 0s. 0d.

The Nominal Horse Power for regulating survey fees on engines and boilers to be determined as described in Section 29.
 For the survey and testing of each Donkey Boiler, a fee of two guineas will be charged.

In exceptional cases an additional charge will be made according to the service performed, and in all cases where travelling
 expenses are incurred by the Surveyors in connexion with the above services, they are to be defrayed by the parties interested.
 In no case can the ship be classed until all fees, travelling expenses, &c., due thereon are paid.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of British
 and Foreign Shipping, which provide that:—
