The 3rd Special Survey No. 1 became due in October, 1934.

The vessel was purchased by the E.R. Management Co. Ltd. in October, 1935, for re-sale for breaking up, & this firm furnished a form of undertaking.

The vessel remained laid up at Glasgow, but has now been reported in the Shipping Papers as sold to Scottish Shipbreakers.

A letter, dated 18th August, has now been received from the Society's Glasgow office, stating that the vessel is being removed from the Gareloch to Troon, where she will be broken up by the West of Scotland Shipbreaking Co.
