Dear Sir,

With reference to your memorandum of the 12th instant intimating that the steamer "KINGSBURY" is still laid up at your port, it is observed from the Shipping Papers that it is reported the vessel has now been resold to Scottish Shipbreakers to be broken up on the Clyde.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will be good enough to ascertain and let me know whether this statement is correct, as, if so, the case will be submitted to the Committee with a view to a notation of "To be broken up" being recorded against the vessel's name in the Register Book, which will automatically cancel her classification.
