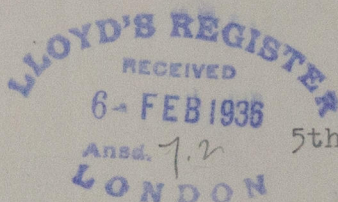

Dear Sir,

We thank you for your favour of the 4th. instant addressed to Messrs. Evans & Reid Coal Co. Ltd., in reference to the ss "KINGSBURY". It is true we have purchased this steamer for breaking up purposes but we have not yet disposed of her and are, therefore, unable to say whether she will be moved from her present lying up berth to another port for breaking up.

We do not require to keep the vessel in Class but may possibly require a Certificate of Sea-worthiness to move her to a port other than GLASGOW purely for breaking up purposes. We explained this position to your Local Representatives sometime ago and will communicate with you again if we require to move the vessel but meantime, you can take it as quite definite that we will not require to maintain her Class.

In respect to the last paragraph of your letter we will retain the Free Board Certificate until such time as we decide what to do with the vessel and will then send it to you unless, of course, we have to hand it over to the Purchasers who may purchase the vessel in GLASGOW as she lies, & then move her for their account.
