Sirs,

Reverting to your letter of the 6th November last  
relative to the steamer "KINGSBURY", I have to inform you that  
vessel arrived at Glasgow last month and is reported to  
be completely discharged on the 19th ultimo.

It would appear from information received from the  
Glasgow Office that the vessel is still lying in the Princes  
at that port, and the Agents have stated that, as yet,  
have no information as to her future disposition.

It is understood from the late Owners that the vessel  
sold by them to be broken up, and as the year of grace for  
3rd Special Survey No.1 has already expired, I shall be  
if you will take the matter up with the new Owners, Messrs.  
Bantham S.S. Co. Ltd., of your port, (Messrs. Evans & Reid),  
ascertain, if possible, at what port the vessel is to be  
broken up.

I would add that, in the ordinary course, the case  
be brought to the notice of the Committee for her class  
be dealt with, unless the new Owners have any proposal to  
put forward for consideration by the Committee.
