With reference to the classification in the
Lloyd's Register Book of the steamer "KINGSBURY", I
inform you that the Owners recently requested
an extension of class might be granted them to
enable the vessel to make a round voyage to the
Mediterranean, when it was understood she might be sold
for breaking up purposes, and this application was granted
after a satisfactory general examination, which was
carried out at Newcastle in October last.

The vessel appears to have now arrived at
Port from Oran, and the Owners, Messrs. Capper,
Baker & Co, had previously advised me that on discharge
at Glasgow she had been sold to Messrs. Evans & Reid, of
Glasgow, for demolition.

I shall be glad if you can kindly ascertain and
advise me whether the vessel is to proceed from your
office to another for demolition, or whether the actual work
of demolition will be carried out in the Clyde.
