

S.S. "LONDON CITIZEN"



The 2nd S.S.No.1 became due 7,33.

The vessel has been laid up since January 1933 and the usual undertaking has been furnished.

It was ascertained from the Shipping Papers that the vessel had left Tollesbury where she was laid up, and had arrived at Burntisland on 2nd instant en route for Rosyth.

The Society's Surveyors at Leith were communicated with, and in reply they state that the vessel is now at the works of Messrs. Metal Industries Id., where she will be broken up, it being expected that the work will commence in about four weeks' time.

It is submitted that the vessel might be posted as "To be broken up".
