With reference to the Second Special Survey No.1 which became due so long ago as July, 1933, on the steamer "LONDON CITIZEN", which has been lying at Tollesbury for some considerable time, I have to acquaint you that it is understood this vessel has been sold to Messrs. The Metal Industries Ltd., for breaking up purposes.

It would appear from the Shipping Papers that the vessel was anchored off Burntisland on the 2nd instant bound for Rosyth, and, in the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know, in course of post, within what time it is anticipated the demolition will be commenced if this has not already taken place.

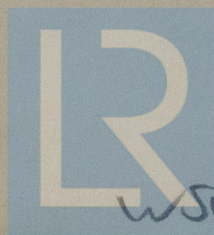
