The steamer's British Certificate of Registry has been delivered to the Registrar of Shipping, Calcutta for forwarding to the Registrar at Liverpool for cancellation.

The steamer is scheduled to leave this port on the 9th inst. under the Japanese flag, a provisional Certificate of Registry having been issued by the Japanese Consulate here.

For your information we quote Clause 4 of the Memorandum of Agreement of Sale as follows:-

4. "Steamer is sold subject to the stipulation that she will be
"broken up and not again traded or put into service except for
"one voyage to the breaking up port, and Purchasers hereby
"undertake that the steamer will be broken up on the completion
"of the said voyage. Purchasers shall, prior to delivery of the

 " Vendors with authenticated advice that this has been done."
