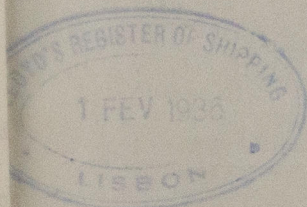

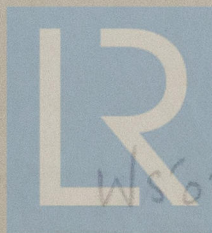
With reference to your memorandum of the 18th November at, I shall be glad to learn what other arrangements have been made the 3rd Special Survey No. 2 to be carried out.

Date:— 11th February 1936.

The vessel is laid up at this Port and is in the hands of the Court following the Bankruptcy of the Company. A verbal statement made today by the Official Receiver is being confirmed by letter, to the effect that he is requesting the Judge to have this survey carried out in view of the vessel having a better value in the event of being sold. He cannot at the moment state how funds will be arranged for the payment of the survey and repairs. Should a request for the survey be made it is suggested that a request be sent to the Official Receiver from this Office for the survey fee to be deposited in the Bank before the survey is commenced, the amount to be paid to our account on the presentation to the Bank of the interim certificate issued from this Office.
