Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith Verification of Marking Form relative to the above named vessel, and in connection with this case and your letter dated 17th March 1933, I have to inform you as follows:-

1. Wood plugs were provided for all air pipes and gooseneck ventilators.
2. Provision has been made for rigging lifelines.
3. The fastenings of the doors of the companionways, fore-castle and bridge bulkheads have been overhauled and repaired to my satisfaction.

I have to acquaint you that the tonnages of this vessel have been altered and the gross tonnage entered on the Certificates as follows:-
