

FREEBOARD REPORT on the

G/L 'Willy'

It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those required by the Tables, merit approval, subject to

- 1) Suitable means being provided for closing the openings of all air pipes of gooseneck ventilators.
- 2) Suitable provision being made for rigging life lines which should be available for use in any part of the ship which might have to be used by the crew in the regular working of the vessel. [to Surveyors Satisfaction]
- 3) Locks on doors of companionways, forecsts of bridge bulkheads being overhauled. The Convention freeboards being less favourable than those at present assigned. The latter have been reassigned.
